The HaloPro Laser is the worlds first Hybrid Fractional laser that applies adjustable non-ablative (1470nm) and ablative (2940) wavelengths to the same microscopic treatment zone to maximize results and reduce downtime. Halo laser creates controlled channels in the dermis, (2nd layer of the skin), that will stimulate new collagen growth and ablate texture. Giving patients the results they want without the discomfort and extended downtime they expect.

You will be red and swollen immediately after laser treatment. This is the response we want! It is normal for redness and swelling to increase for the first 3 days. Redness can persist for up to 7-10 days depending on the intensity of your treatment.

Pinpoint bleeding can occur. This is normal and can last for up to 12 hours depending on the depth of treatment. It is also normal for the pinpoint bleeding to be isolated to certain treated areas.

Immediately after treatment, swelling is common and expected. Use of a cold compress or ice packs will help to reduce the swelling. The first morning after treatment is when swelling is more prevalent, especially under the eyes. Swelling may last 2-4 days depending on the intensity of the treatment.

To avoid further swelling:

- You may choose to sleep in an upright position the first night after treatment
- Avoid caffeine and alcoholic beverages
- Avoid strenuous physical activities for the first 24 hours after treatment

Treated area may be extremely warm for 12-24 hours after the procedure. Cold compresses or ice packs may provide comfort during this time. On the 2nd or 3rd day after treatment, you will

notice tiny dark spots and bronzed appearance to the treated skin. This is called the MENDS (microscopic epidermal necrotic debris). In individuals with heavily pigmented skin or in areas where sun damage has produced pigmented lesions, the microscopic wounds contain large amounts of melanin. Because there are so many MENDS, they can make the skin look bronzed and small areas appear crusted (do not try to scratch them off). This part of the healing process where treated tissue is working its way out of your body as fresh skin is regenerated. At this time, your skin will be very dry and have a sandpaper texture and will begin to flake and peel. The face can take anywhere from 5-7 days for the peeling process to be completed. Neck, chest, or anywhere on the body can take up to 2 weeks.

After the peeling process is complete, you skin will have a rosy pink glow that will gradually resolve. Post treatment discomfort may be relieved by over the counter oral pain relievers such as, Extra Strength Tylenol or prescribed pain medication if ordered by the doctor.

Itching may be experienced during the healing phase and is completely normal. Oral Benadryl may help itching but a can cause drowsiness.

DO NOT scratch the treated area as scarring and pigmentation complications can occur.
